Just a year ago here we spoke about a world "seemingly in turmoil". Looking back twelve month those days seem almost halcyon. Locally, however, the news - and the outlook - is good. As we celebrate the 35th year of its revival, the Golowan Festival - and Penzance - is "On the Crest of a Wave".

Despite the potential for difficulties with development work close to Golowan's footprint, at Coineagehall, we are delighted to report that the Quay Fair will remain in its popular location on Battery Road again while the Golowan Marquee breaks exciting new ground by moving to a new site, the Wharfside Maritime Car Park by the harbour.

That harbour location ties in neatly with our theme this year – "On the Crest of a Wave". This demonstrates our confidence for Golowan and its future and for our town and community at large. We anticipate a tidal wave of optimism and joy on Mazey Day with nautical parade images surging through the town in a massive blue wave. Every year Golowan faces new challenges but with them come exciting opportunities and this year the joy of the festival will spread like a benevolent tsunami all over town.

For two days over Mazey Weekend, Penlee Park will be filled with music, community celebrations, youth & family activities, craft & food stalls, a bar - and much more.

On Mazey Day, Morrab Gardens Bandstand will again host a wonderful afternoon of live music. All the old favourites remain, of course, with vibrant street music throughout the town, market stalls thronging Market Jew Street and Greenmarket Car Park transformed on Mazey Day to "Festival Square" with world food stalls and the ever-popular Folk Stage at the Acorn Theatre wall.

On Quay Fair Day – while the Penlee Park Event continues to thrive up in town - the festivities will continue down by the harbour with the addition of the Golowan Mini Sea Shanty Festival at the Dry Dock, market stalls, shanty crews, Morris dancers and the Folk Stage on South Quay entertaining the crowds throughout the day. Meanwhile, in its new location, from hosting the Mock Mayor Ceremony on Thursday 26th June right through to late Quay Fair Day, the Golowan Marquee will continue to provide its own very special musical delights. Add in the Firework Display (thank you Penzance Council!) followed by the Serpent Dance on Mazey Eve and it all adds up to yet another magical celebration of "one of the best community festivals in the West".

# Important Stuff! Taklow Posek!

#### LOST CHILDREN

Golowan becomes very busy, and we ask that you keep your children close. We recommend that children under the age of 16 be accompanied by an adult. Make sure they have your mobile phone number on them, even write it on their arm! If you lose your child, please contact a Golowan steward. Look out for their identification tag and Golowan t-shirt or hi-viz vest/jacket.

#### TRAVELLING

If you come by car, to avoid congestion and long queues, we recommend you park in the spacious St. Erth train station car park and take the train for the one stop to Penzance, a 5 min walk to the festival.

#### By Train:

Great Western Railway operates at Penzance station. Book your ticket on the Trainline App or on www.gwr.com.

#### By Bus:

Buses operate into and out of the main bus station (next to the train station and a 5-minute walk to the festival). Check with the service provider for up-to-date information.

#### By Car.

Follow the A30 to Penzance and follow signs for car parking.

#### **CAR PARKS**

Free parking is available at Penwith College (8am to 9pm), on a first come, first served basis.

The other paid-for car park is at the Wharfside Car Park next to the bus and train station. The Greenmarket and St Anthony's car parks will not be available.

# DISABLED VIEWING AREA FOR THE SATURDAY PARADES

Available on Market Jew Street, near the entrance to the Wharfside shopping centre. Accessed from the Harbour Long Stay Car Park using the lift to the first floor at the top of the escalator and exiting at the Market Jew Street entrance.

#### **TOILETS**

Portable and disabled toilets available on Mazey Day in Festival Square (Greenmarket Car Park), outside St John's Hall, Jennings Street and in Penlee Park (Penlee House also has a disabled access toilet). On Quay Fair Day next to the public toilets (on the South Quay), and in Penlee Park.

The following businesses participate in the Penzance Community Toilet Scheme: The Longboat Inn, Market Jew Street; Poppies, Belgravia St; Subway, Causewayhead; Waves Café Bar, Causewayhead; Penlee House, Penlee Park; Exchange Gallery, Princess St; The Lugger Inn, The Promenade; The Dolphin Tavern, Quay St.; Newlyn Gallery, New Rd, Newlyn; Duke Street Cafe, Duke St, Newlyn; The Swordfish Inn, The Strand, Newlyn.

#### **MEDICAL PROVISION**

On Mazey Eve in the harbour area. On Mazey Day in Market Jew Street near Domino's Pizzas, at the top of Morrab Road and in Penlee Park. On Quay Fair Day in the harbour area and by the Skate Park on the Prom.

From medieval times Mock Mayors were 'elected' by public acclamation in many Cornish, English and European towns and villages, poking fun at the authorities and causing a bit of good –natured mischief, the Lords of Misrule.

Candidates create their characters and ludicrous manifestos. They have a short time to introduce themselves and their manifestos on a stage in front of the baying crowd. If the crowd boos they are unceremoniously removed! Lord Justice Socks, a beloved Golowan figure, oversees the proceedings. The candidate with the loudest cheers wins and will stand with Penzance's official mayor to address the town from the steps of the Market House on Mazey Day.

# GOLOWAN WAZEY WEEKEND

#### CENTRE PULL OUT!

The Golowan festival is held in Penzance and is a 10-day festival of Cornish arts, performances, culture, and parades that culminate in a street festival on the last weekend in June where thousands attend a spectacle of giant model parades, street performances, street music, theatre, and the Golowan live music and DJ Marquee. This annual event is much loved and is the biggest event in the calendar for the southwest Cornish community. It is a 35-year revival festival of the Feast of St. John and the midsummer solstice that is delivered by the whole community and grown into one of the biggest street festivals in South England. On Mazey Day Greenmarket Car Park will again magically transform into 'Festival Square' where enticing food stalls share the bustling space with the Folk Stage which presents a variety of music, dance, and song all day from 10am. Between parades local school and youth bands entertain the crowds by the Sir Humphry Davy statue.

Street music is performed throughout the town at The Globe and in front of the Co-op in Queen Square, the steps of The Acorn Theatre and on the bandstand in Morrab Gardens. The Farmers Arms electric stage will host bands at the top of Causewayhead, while towards the Harbour the Dock Inn & the Dolphin will provide an energetic session of rock music till the late afternoon. There is a take-over of the two fields of Penlee Park with two stages, a bar and an array of delicious food stalls, right in the centre of Penzance! Delight in the Youth Music Stage highlights, Penwith's array of young musical talent, community performances and DJ sessions. Experience the Golowan Sea Shanty Festival with bar and hog roast on Quay Fair Day Sunday 29th at the Dry Dock!

The Golowan Marquee hosted by the Cornish Crown is in the Wharfside Harbour Car Park and will supply an array of lively music throughout the weekend, building to a crescendo long into the night!
